



On Monday, October 24th, a member of our speed skating community – Ian Hudey, 17 — was in a major car accident near White City. He suffered several broken bones and some very serious internal injuries. He is now in stable condition, but under heavy sedation. Doctors won't know the full extent of his injuries, but they are testing him while working on his other injuries. Ian's family has been by his side since the accident happened. They are all holding up as well as can be expected and trying to stay strong for Ian.

All of us who know the Hudey family are concerned for Ian and his family. Donna Holmes and I, along with many other members of the Regina Speed Skating Club, are putting on a Fundraiser Supper to assist Ian and his family. The fundraiser will be held on November 12th, 5-6:30 pm at the Argyle Park Community Center. Supper is buffet-style by Charlotte's Catering from Moose Jaw. Tickets are \$20 for adults, \$12 for ages 7-17 and free for ages 6 and under.

Ian also has close ties to the Regina soccer community, as he played on the Team Saskatchewan this summer at the U18 Nationals, so we welcome anyone from outside the speed skating community to join us in supporting the Hudey family.
